

# **THE RANDOLPH PLANNING BOARD**

## **Minutes of Public Hearing and Meeting**

**Feb. 4, 2016**

The chairman opened the meeting at 7:10. Bob moved that the minutes of the December meeting be approved as written. Roberta seconded the motion and it was adopted.

The chairman then opened the public hearing.

John explained that long term contracts of the Forest Commission have to be approved by the Planning Board. The contract under discussion concerned the building of the trail from Bowman parking to Rollo Falls and the Crystal Mine Trail. The Forest Commission will pay the RMC for building the trails and maintenance.

Roberta moved for approval by the Planning Board and Arlene seconded. The vote was unanimous. Hearing was closed.

A discussion followed concerning the Master Plan and the comments from the public hearing. John mentioned the concern of one resident about not including a survey to North Country Council and was told this was not unusual. Many towns were no longer following the old format. The board was also reminded that the MP could be approved after a public hearing as mentioned in 675.6.

Arlene made a motion to adopt the 2016 Master Plan . Roberta seconded and the vote was unanimous for approval.

It was mentioned that David Willcox will be an alternate for the Forest Commission.

Our yearly updates of municipal notes with Bernie Waugh will take place at the April meeting.

The meeting was adjourned by general consent at 8:20 pm.
