DISCUSSION ITEMS AND MOTIONS:

Chief Alan Lowe brought in a letter to the board stating he has not qualified in firearms through a Certified Arms Instructor. The Chief has written to the director of NH Police Standards requesting to be qualified at their indoor facility in Concord and is waiting for a response. Until then, Chief Lowe will not carry a firearm, but maintain his duties; checking homes, patrolling town, responding to fire and ambulance calls and be available to secure the scene of vehicle accidents. The board is unsure of what the New Hampshire State guidelines are and while waiting for the response from the director of NH Police Standards, they will research the qualifications required of an active duty police officer.

The Town has received a PA-7 Timber Cut from the Town of Gorham. A bond was required and provided by Liberty Mutual Surety. The board reviewed and approved the PA-7.

Dillon Lowe has been hired as a backup driver and support for the Highway Department. Dillon is fully qualified and has acquired his CDL. Linda Dupont stated; Dillon was scheduled for a pre-hire physical as required by NH DOT.

Kelley Trucking has been called in for snow removal and pushing back snow banks on Glover Spring Road, and High Acres Road, cutting back the large banks of the intersections.

The board commended Kevin for doing a great job clearing the town's roadways with so many storms so early in the season.

David Woodward from Avitar Associates has been in the office. 280 letters were sent to property owners for data verification. Dave has set up appointments with homeowners for in house verification of the accuracy of the information on the property cards in the assessing program. Those who could not schedule an appointment, the data can be verified verbally over the phone.

Lauren Bradley volunteered to send letters thanking the Gorham EMS, Gorham Fire Department, Sheriff's Department and State Officers for their response to the accident on Hodgdon Hill Wednesday January 3rd. Many of Randolph's first responders were unavailable at the time of this accident.

The next meeting will be held on January 22, 2018.

John Turner moved to adjourn at 7:55 PM. All agreed.
